The 7th US/German Workshop on Salt Repository Research, Design, and Operation will be held at the Embassy Suites by Hilton Crystal City – National Airport on September 7-9, 2016.

- Due to DOE requirements, we will not be able to open the conference registration until mid-May 2016, at which time we will add the links to the 7th Workshop website for the conference registration/payment and hotel registration
- Conference registration/fee payments will be closed on August 15, 2016, at which time we must pay the hotel for all conference room and food/beverage charges in advance

- The room rate is \$222 per night (DC Federal Government per diem rate)– includes breakfast, Manager's Reception, WiFi connections in sleeping rooms, hotel shuttle between Reagan National Airport and the hotel, location is close to Metro stations for easy and convenient local transportation
- A block of 50 rooms has been arranged with the Embassy Suites.
- Conference registration fee will be \$300 – includes two lunches, AM and PM refreshments, conference room rental, A/V equipment, and WiFi connections in conference rooms, plus the hosted dinner
- Check-in on September 6, check-out on September 9
- Meeting is scheduled for all day September 7 and 8, and for the morning only on September 9
- Workshop dinner will be Thursday, September 8. Details will follow.
